

Kenya Wildlife Safaris

13 nights/ 14 days

Amboseli National Park, Tsavo East & West National Parks, Mombasa

Day 1

You will be met at Nairobi Airport and transferred to your hotel in this bustling city. Check in and relax in your warm and friendly African surroundings.

Day 2: Amboseli National Park

On this day of your Kenya beach safari head out to one of Kenya's Premier National Parks, **Amboseli**. Beautifully situated beneath the foot of Africa's highest mountain Mt. Kilimanjaro (5895m), the park is well renowned for its huge herds of elephants and various types of other Savannah wildlife such as Giraffes, Bushbuck's, Kudu, Warthog's, Zebra's and over 425 species of birds recorded here. The snowcapped peak of Kilimanjaro rising above white clouds dominates every aspect of Amboseli and forms a backdrop to an impressive display of wildlife attracted to this location by swamps and springs fed by underground rivers from Kilimanjaro's melting snow. With an airstrip at Empusel Gate, the park is also home to the Masai people, those tall, brave, and proud nomads who live in close harmony with the environment and the wildlife that surrounds them. Amboseli was the location around which such famous writers like Sir Ernest Hemingway and Robert Ruark tailored their stories of big game hunting in the wilds of Africa. Enjoy a game drive en-route, as we arrive in time for your lunch at the OLTUKAI LODGE, situated deep in the heart of the world famous Amboseli National Park. **Dinner & Overnight at OLTUKAI LODGE.** (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)

Day 3: Amboseli National Park

A dawn game drive will be the perfect time for photographing the humbling and magnificent **Mt. Kilimanjaro** the highest peak in Africa. We return to the lodge for breakfast and some R&R "rest and relaxation", sunbathing, swimming or for those of you reading enthusiasts, you can read the day away in the well-stocked library with a relaxing view of Mt. Kilimanjaro, In the afternoon set out on a game drive in the park where you will enjoy sundowners while watching the sun slip below the horizon.. All meals and **Overnight at OLTUKAI LODGE.** (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)

Day 4: Tsavo West National Park

Continue your journey to one of the largest National Parks in the world, **Tsavo**, heading to the Western side for an afternoon game drive. The Elephants here are often reddish coloured due to dust bathing in the red coloured soil. The park is the location of Africa's most famous adventure story "Man eaters of Tsavo", a100 years ago, in which two lions where responsible for eating over 500 workers who where building the Uganda railway also known as the "Lunatic Line " by it's opponents in the British Parliament in 1898. The story was made famous in the 1996 movie "*The Ghost and the Darkness.*" Enjoy your lunch at **KILANGUNI SERENA LODGE.** Conveniently located in the heart of the park, the lodge offers captivating views of the majestic Mt. Kilimanjaro and the Chyulu Hills. Only 100m from the main building, is a water hole where animals come to quench their thirst. Each of the 53 rooms has a private shower, toilet, and a verandah (Patio) overlooking the waterhole and Africa's highest mountain, snowcapped Mt. Kilimanjaro. With it's own airstrip nearby, Kilanguni lodge is the place to be. **Dinner & overnight at KILANGUNI SERENA LODGE.** (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)

Day 05: TSAVO WEST - TSAVO EAST

Soon after breakfast with game en-route through the vast **Tsavo National Park** we will depart Tsavo West for our today's major game drive at Tsavo East. You will check-in at **VOI SAFARI LODGE** for your lunch. Perched on the top of a cliff faced hill, voi safari lodge is uniquely designed to be a hinge like structure overlooking the Tsavo east plains extending as far as the undulating terrain of the Yatta plateaus. This vantage positioning of the lodge has made it a stopover for many safari adventures, nature lovers and holiday makers who are assured of sampling Kenya's wildlife attractions that continuously beat a track to the three water holes sunk by the lodge below the cliff. During the dry season the waterholes are the convergence of a lot of wild animals moving almost in a radial flies as if urged on by some kind of telephatic communication, the sight is just fantastic. The location evokes a romantic inspiration that once moved a visiting British poet who now incorporated his experience at the lodge in most of his poems, to describe it as sample of wonder that is better than a dream. The visitors to the lodge have the rare chance of coming as close as a breath away from the wild animals in a specially designed tunnel with protective barricades that has proved popular for Post Card quality close-ups of Kenya's wildlife. The 52 roomed lodge is designed to blend with the rocky surroundings and boats of a unique dug up rock swimming pool with the surroundings dotted by wild flora planted around the lodge. The lodge is also proving popular with the travelers along the Mombasa - Nairobi highway, located 165kms from Mombasa and has the advantage of being within a park that is served with a good infrastructure including communication facilities. After few hours relaxation you will enjoy a late afternoon before you retire for day at VOI SAFARI LODGE for dinner and overnight.

Day 6: Mombasa, Diani Beach

Leaving the wilds of Tsavo, head for the coastal haven of **Mombasa**, where you have the remainder of the day to explore the vibrant south coast town. Enjoy your Mombasa beach holiday and relax on the beautiful sandy white beach and sip a refreshing cocktail. Take in the tropical beauty of the coastline. **Boabab Beach Resort** (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)

Day 7 - 13: Mombasa, Diani Beach

You will have the next **7 nights** during your Kenya beach resort holiday to enjoy at your leisure and savour the laidback African beach lifestyle. Work on your tan, play a game of volleyball, go sailing, jet-skiing or snorkelling. Cool off with a refreshing dip in the Ocean before savouring a leisurely lunch. **Boabab Beach Resort** (Breakfast and Dinner Included)

Day 14: Mombasa

On the final morning of your Kenya & Mombasa Safari Beach Holiday there might be time for one last dip in the Ocean before a lingering breakfast after which you will fly out from Mombasa International Airport to your onward destination. (Breakfast Included)
